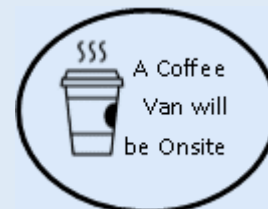
- See the 2018 Drop Ewes drafted into Sire x Dam Type Groups -
