Several of the long winded and convoluted submissions so far received have been advocates of unskirted fleece lines. I feel very strongly about this, and like and try to be brief and concise.

All advocates of this procedure are wrong, and have been mislead.

All unskirted fleece lines are glorified pieces. There is a misconception with many Wool Growers that sweat points will scour out. This is NOT true, and never has been true.

Allowing unskirted wools to go to Auction is a disgrace, except the three C's, coloured, cotted and carpet wools.

I am relieved that there is Mr James Lillie on the committee, otherwise I would be very apprehensive of the recommendations coming forward, on this matter.

There is no point saving costs, if you take value off the selling price.
